Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship Program (Phase – II)



The subj scholarship has been offered for the undergraduate students of **Spring 2020 & Fall 2020 (First & Second Sem Only)**. Interested candidates are required to apply through the online application system and submit its hard copy along with complete set of the requisite documentation to Students Facilitation Center (SFC) from 15th Sep, 2020 onwards.

<u>Eligibility Criteria</u> of the scholarship is as follows:

- a) Students who are enrolled in undergraduate Degree Program (First & Second Sem Only).
- b) Candidates who have secured admission on merit; Merit means that the student has fulfilled admission criteria of the respective university in which he/ she intends to study.
- c) Age limit will be followed as per the university regulations i.e. maximum age under which an applicant is allowed to take admission for offered Undergraduate program at the university.
- d) Students already availing any other scholarship or grant are ineligible.
- e) Students who have secured admission on evening/ self-sustain/ self-support/ self-finance programs are ineligible.
- f) Distant learning students are ineligible.
- g) Applying <u>ONLINE</u> on web portal and submission of application in <u>Hard Form</u> along with supporting documents to SFC, PR&SA Cen is <u>MANDATORY</u>, otherwise he/ she will be ineligible for the award. The link is http://ehsaas.hec.gov.pk/site/Ehsaas;
- h) Last date to apply is 30th Nov, 2020.

Eligible candidates are also required to submit following documents along with the hard copy of application form

- a) Copy of CNIC (Father, Mother/ Guardian)
- b) Salary Slip/Income Certificate (Father, Mother/ Guardian)
- c) Copies of last six month utility bills (Electricity, Gas, Telephone, Water), if applicable.
- d) Copy of Rent agreement in case of Rented House
- e) Copies of medical bills/ expenditure related documents. If applicable
- f) 1x passport size latest photograph of applicant.
- g) Picture of applicant house.

<u>NOTE:</u> Incomplete application forms with missing documents may not be considered for the said scholarships.
